



ACTIVITY: WITH YOUR TEAM, PLOT THE 12 MOST COMMON SONGS PLAYED IN SERVICES AT YOUR CHURCH ABOVE. DO YOU HAVE THE BALANCE YOU WANT? WHAT'S LACKING? ARE MOST OF YOUR SONGS INSIDE THE CIRCLE?

EXAMPLES: "MADE ALIVE" BY CITIZENS WOULD BE AROUND PLOT POINT A. "SINS ARE STONES" BY JOHN MARK MCMILLAN WOULD LAND AROUND PLOT POINT B.

CELEBRATION: SONGS THAT ANNOUNCE THE TRIUMPH OF CHRIST, VICTORY OVER DEATH AND SIN, FOCUS ON HIS RESURRECTION. SEE PSALM 33, 57, 67 **STRUGGLE:** SONGS OF CONFESSION, MOURNING, OR HARDSHIP. TYPICALLY CONTEMPLATIVE. SEE PSALM 3, 71, 79 **SUBJECTIVE:** FOCUS ON OUR THOUGHTS, EMOTIONS, AND RESPONSE TO WHAT GOD HAS DONE. LOTS OF "I", "WE" AND "MY LANGUAGE IS USED. SEE PSALM 26, 31, 38 **OBJECTIVE:** SIMPLE DECLARATIONS OF WHAT GOD HAS DONE AND GOD'S CHARACTER CHRIST'S WORK ON THE CROSS IS MOST COMMON. SEE PSALM 11, 47, 104
